

Will you help us restore The Gardens?

Birmingham Botanical Gardens have unveiled ambitious plans for the largest re-development programme in their history.

The £13m 'Growing our Green Heritage Project' will transform the 191-year-old charity, restoring its four historic, listed glasshouses, providing additional visitor and community resources and creating a place of horticultural excellence and outstanding green space.

Last year the Botanical Gardens were awarded £590,814 development funding from the National Lottery Heritage Fund to develop the first phase of the project, with a further £4.4m available as the programme progresses.

"Birmingham Botanical Gardens have been providing a haven of natural peace and tranquility for more than 190 years," said Chief Executive Sara Blair-Manning.

"We are now at a crucial moment in the Gardens' history; the glasshouses are in urgent need of upgrading and without significant investment the viability of these unique Botanical Gardens will become increasingly difficult. This hugely exciting project will breathe new life into the site, promoting the value of nature and green spaces to all and demonstrating how botanical gardens can help in conserving plant biodiversity and increasing public understanding of environmental and sustainability issues.

Our vision is for Birmingham Botanical Gardens to remain as the green heart of the city for the next 200 years as a space that welcomes everyone, and we need everyone to play their part in helping to save this precious place" she added.

The best way to help the gardens progress these exciting plans is to become an active supporter by taking out a membership (either for yourselves or as a gift for someone) or becoming a volunteer.
