#### **EMPOWERING FUTURES**

### PLAYING OUR PART IN INNOVATIVE YOUTH PROJECT

We've partnered with a local mosque on an innovative youth leadership programme that has a positive impact on youth crime. Youngsters are trained in leadership to improve their confidence and understanding of the complexities of community violence and to take ownership of community resolutions.

Bahu Trust mosque, Balsall Heath, has designed the Empowering Futures programme for 14 to 17-year-olds who are at risk of being drawn into crime or falling out of education.

The fortnightly sessions – many of which are held at Edgbaston Stadium – are designed to enable young people to take part in professional and interactive training in order to reach their intellectual and creative capability. This boosts confidence, team working and steer participants towards positive futures.

They have included leadership mentoring, conflict resolution coaching and inputs from youth violence specialists, local community and West Midlands Police officers on gangs, role model theories and violent crimes.

The boys have organized their own **community projects** including helping out at food banks, community clean-ups and delivering hampers to elderly, vulnerable people.

These are young people who come from deprived areas and remain at risk of coming to the attention of the police or being drawn into anti-social behaviour. Empowering Futures is all about **developing their natural leadership**, showing them there is an alternative and encouraging them to maximise their potential.

We're grateful that Edgbaston has partnered with us on this project; I'm confident it will help the police cut community crime and make a positive impact on the lives of the young men involved
